## What is the MCFB 4-2-7 Project?

The project is for children aged between 4 and 7 years, who are experiencing difficulties in managing the transition from home/nursery to school, and may require extra support. Such difficulties could include; difficulty forming relationships and socialising with others, behavioural issues at school or low self-esteem and confidence. We aim to work with predominantly, but not exclusively, BME children and families. The project is open to BME children and families from across Edinburgh and White/Scottish families in the North of the city.

## How will we do this?

- One-to-one work with children in home or in school
- Work with families
- Parenting skills work
- Improving home-school communication
- Group work with children

## What are the aims of the project?

- To promote cognitive development
- To improve language skills
- To help children to form relationships with other children and adults
- To help children learn to solve problems, resolve conflict and make decisions
- To promote self-esteem, self-confidence and resilience
- To promote a positive sense of self-identity and an understanding of others
- To help children to explore, understand and express their emotions
- To help children to understand and control their behaviour
- To help children to develop positive attitudes towards learning and school
